BEAUTIFUL BORGIO

Borgio Egnazia officially opened this April, as the newest luxury family property to open in Italy. Jessica Way heads out to the resort, acclaimed to become one of the leading luxury family retreats in the Mediterranean.

Located between Bari and Brindisi, ten years in the making, the Borgio (village), guided by the vision of talented artist Pino Brescia, is a creation of a modern Eden, built entirely of indigenous local resources and constructed as a modern interpretation of the original 5th century BC city of Egnazia. The glittering new beacon among 5-star Apulia hotels has 28 private three-bedroom villas, 63 guest rooms and suites, a village area with 93 Apulian townhouses, a 1,800 square metre Puglia Spa complete with a replica Roman bath house, and an 18-hole San Domenico golf



course with views across the Adriatic Sea. Staying in a 55 square meter townhouse in the Il Borgio village, where the buildings are designed by hand, carved by traditional craftsmen, using local stone and wood, was uniquely sensational. The overall effect, including quaint cobblestone streets, a church, a piazza and entire village of townhouses, was absolutely charming.
